+ Placement:

Dancers will be placed into Company & Team levels based off of audition and director decision. Dancers are not guaranteed placement on IDA Company & Team levels. If your dancer is not placed on a IDA Company & Team level, He or she will participate as an IDA apprentice and receive a curated schedule of classes in order to build a stronger foundation in dance.

Number of group routines, specialties, styles of routines, choreographer, costuming, dancer's placement within the company / team and all other aspects of the company & team are the director's decision.

+ Tuition & Fees:

Monthly Tuition & Fees are due by the first of the month to IDA. Fees are determined by level of company / team & amount of rehearsal time. Parents will receive a calendar of when all fees such as costumes, competition & performance fees are due at the beginning of the season. High School Seniors and all male dancers receive 50% off their tuition fees.

+ Vision

Indy Dance Academy Company & Team levels offer the dedicated dancer the opportunity to discover their own potential and further their technical training, while experiencing the camaraderie of a team.

Levels within our Company & Team provide the dancer opportunities for individual growth in their dance education through curriculum based technique classes and training in multiple styles of dance techniques.

Along with a strong focus on the dancer's technical education, dancers will participate in studio performances, regional and national competitions, conventions and outreach performances throughout the Indianapolis community.

+ Team Levels

Indy Dance Academy Team (IDAT) is geared to the dancer interested in accomplishing the skill set necessary for high school and college dance teams. Dancers will study techniques in Ballet, Jazz and Hip Hop. Dancers will also focus on full body conditioning and stretch.

Team Performance and Competition Levels:

Amethyst Team* (approx. ages 6-10)

Ruby Team (approx. ages 8-18)

**Amethyst Team is a performance only level. Dancers will not compete.*

+ Ruby Competition Team:

Ruby Audition Requirements:

- Approx. ages 8-18
- Minimum 2 years of dance education or by Director's invitation.
- Preferred 1 year of performance experience or Director's invitation.

Ruby Season Requirement:

- Dancers will be assigned 3 hrs. and 45 mins. of training per week
 - 1 hour Ballet Class
 - 1 hour Jazz Class
 - 1-45 min. Jazz Rehearsal
 - 1 hour Hip Hop Rehearsal & Conditioning
- Dancers will be cast in 2 competition group routines: *Hip Hop & Jazz*
 - Group routines will require weekly rehearsal times that are separate from required technique hours
- Compete at 2 local dance competitions
- Participate in up to 2 dance conventions per the season schedule
- Participate in IDA performances & Outreach performances

- Participate in IDA Showcase Production.

Additional rehearsals will be required after Jan. 1st. Showcase Production will perform in all acts at the IDA recital.

- Represent IDA as an assistant at IDA events & fundraisers



+ Amethyst Performance Team:

Amethyst Audition Requirements:

- Approx. ages 6-10
- Minimum 1 year of dance education or by Director's invitation.

Amethyst Season Requirement:

- Assigned 3 hrs. of training per week
 - 1 hour Ballet Class
 - 1 hour Jazz Class
 - 1 hour Hip Hop Class
- Participate in IDA performances & Outreach performances
- Participate in IDA Showcase Production. Additional rehearsals will be required after Jan. 1st. Showcase Production will perform in all acts at the IDA recital.
- Participate in IDA Dance Convention located at Indy Dance Academy. Dancers may also be invited by director to attend 1 local convention
- Follow Team Handbook Policies & Season Calendar.

+ Apprenticeship Program

IDA's Apprenticeship Program is designed for dancers who are interested in growing their dance technique & their performance qualities. This program is perfect for the dancer who wishes to take multiple classes per week & desires to become a part of the company & team in the future.

IDA Apprentice dancers will receive a curated schedule of assigned classes from the Dance Director and will be asked for their participation in the following performances & events...

- Participate in IDA Performances: Recital and Holiday Hoopla. *Note not all IDA classes participate in Holiday Hoopla.*
- Participate in Showcase Production. *Additional rehearsals will be required after Jan. 1st. Showcase Production will perform in all acts at the IDA recital.*
- Participate in IDA Dance Convention located at Indy Dance Academy
- Attend 1 local dance competition as an observer.
